

# DAVID HOLLAND

David Holland is a fine art oil painter living and working in Oklahoma City.

"I'm an avid sky watcher. The skies and cloudscapes I study here, are among the most varied and entertaining to be found anywhere in the world. I relish every moment of time I spend observing and photographing storms, and then I use my photographs to capture in oil paintings their timeless beauty and undeniable power. I consider each painting to be a portrait of an individual storm frozen in motion with accurate colorful details that work to represent its unique personality. I think of the storms I witness as a blessing that distribute the essential building block of all life on Earth -- WATER."

David was born in Lawton Oklahoma in 1959 into an Army family; so, he traveled extensively as a child, living on bases in Oklahoma, Kansas, Japan, Idaho, Maryland, and Arkansas before his family permanently settled in Oklahoma City in 1977. His lifelong interest in creating art began at an early age and during his career he has created multiple series of artworks. He is now best known for using lush color and heightened contrast to paint dramatic cloudscapes in his own realistic style.

The Oklahoma Museum of Art has played a significant role twice in his development as an artist. In 1983, while a junior at Oklahoma City University, two of his works, a black and white pencil drawing of the interior of a pioneer cabin and a watercolor of an ancient bristlecone pine juried into the member's annual exhibition. And in 1995 when his large format pencil drawing of the reflection of downtown OKC in the mirrored columns in front of the newly built Leadership Square won Best of Show at an exhibition hosted by the downtown OMA.

Due to an industrial accident in 1983, David lost sight in his left eye and had to learn to "re-see" things in a new 2-dimensional world. He graduated in 1984 from OCU with a BA degree in art and worked in several jobs.

From 1989 until 2012 he and his partner ran a very successful copper birdfeeder business; then in 2006, an OVAC Creative Capitol seminar gave him the tools and confidence he needed to take the leap of faith to pursue his long-time goal of becoming a full-time artist and finally in 2012 when they sold their business, he began devoting himself full time to creating his artwork.



Recent exhibitions of his work have included the Oklahoma Hall of Fame, the Governor's Gallery, Mainsite Contemporary, Science Museum Oklahoma, the National Weather Center, the National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum, and the Myriad Botanical Gardens.
